IS COMMUNISM A CRIME ?

Many of us used to worship the BBC for News and comments that are reliable, authentic, educative and balanced. But some differences started cropping when the COLD WAR adorned the garbs of Reaganomics and Thatcherism from the eighties.

The situation became really bad when the Soviet Union broke up and, was followed with the jubilant and frenzy reports and comments of "the collapse of communism." Then the recent celebrations, in many forms, of the 10th anniversary of the fall of the BERLIN WALL still go on as onslaught on communism and the former Soviet Union as if they are criminals.

BBC, please tell me and many curious listeners around: IS COMMUNISM A CRIME ?

I know every Country in Western Europe, except Norway. Even Britain was like my second country until they deprived me of my precious property in North London in 1984 unjustly and grossly underpaid compensation which included furniture. A four floor building. I could not fight then because of accident. I had been black-listed as a communist since mid-fifties till now.

I also know the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and all the Socialist countries in Eastern and Central Europe. Korea, China and Mongolia are well known to me. Though none of these countries have attained the stage of communism, they, in the socialist stage, are by far ahead of the Western Countries in building organised society and economy that promote the spirit of patriotism and internationalism.

Gangsterism, organised crime, ponographers, sex on stage, drug cartels, harbouring looters from any country, prostitution prevalent in the Western countries and America, were not in Socialist Countries. What we now see in those countries are the worst human problems in human history. NOT REPORTED BY BBC. In 1961 the democratically elected Prime Minister of Democratic Republic of Congo was assassinated by America C.I.A. And, Dag Hammarskjold, UN secretary General who insisted on justice died in a Air crash, masterminded by the same killer gang and businessmen. Lumumba's offence was his friendship with Nkrumah, Ghana and favourable disposition to Moscow. He was replaced by Mobutu who was Tyrant and looter for 32 years. He gave much of the wealth of his country to Western companies who now finance rebelling in Congo.

Fidel Castro of Cuba was to be deposed and eliminated by US armed Cuban exiles, backed by US forces in 1961. It was a shameful disaster for the US. It is remembered today as THE BAY OF PIGS. Despite multiple embargo on Cuba, there have been many attempts at Castro's life. Fault finding by set-up and provocations have still not succeeded to overthrow communist (in fact socialist) rule.

The Vietnamese overthrew French Colonial rule. Not without ending with division into two (North and South) at the Geneva Conference in 1954. Immediately the US started supporting the South with economic and military aid to "save" them from communism. Followed by full military intervention in 1964 until criticism from home and abroad forced them to withdraw in 1973. The Country was united in 1975. Since the US went back to Vietnam in big business, corruption, smuggling and drug trafficking prevail.

Salvador Allende won a popular democratic Presidential election in Chile. He wanted to effect some changes that will alleviate the suffering of his people by democratic means. American Industry and C.I.A Organised a Military coup that killed him because he was a communist. Today Chile is back to poverty, superstition and voodoo worship while few favoured Chileans work with American business to suck dry what is left of the country BBC does not report the plight of Chileans dying in penny. IS COMMUNISM A CRIME ?

A book published in America early 1965 by Wise and Ross, described as the "invisible Government" gave details of American covert operations all over the world to overthrow, kill, change election fortunes and cause internal conflicts. The worse is to create humanitarian problems and come back and pretend to be donors to help solve the problems.

In November 1965 a booklet appeared in Nigerian streets sold by people's Book Centre, 49 Simpson Street, Ebute Metta, titled BEWARE OF AMERICAN FRIENDSHIP. It was written by OMORODION OMOREGBE. The bookshop which sold many publications for and against the two systems- CAPITALISM and COMMUNISM - died with the BIAFRAN WAR

When Jimmy Carter became President of US in 1977, he was horrified by the activities of the C.I.A. He quickly clipped the wings. But as soon as Ronald Reagan became President, he gave the organisation more powers and more funds. So much that the covert operations became overt.

Bill Clinton, today, boasts of pursuing American interests and values all over the world. He adds always that what he cannot get through diplomacy, he would use force.

The world practice is to use fraud, cajolery and deceit. For instance, it is in intelligence secret record that some diplomat in US Embassy was friendly with some members of O Iraq establishment. He passed the message in a way that it would reach the Presidency after the eight years Gulf war which Iraq waged against Iran in favour of America: "You (Iraq) are so strong, why can't you take this opportunity to take back your territory, Kuwait!" That was it. The US went to UN security and got majority by Cajolery and blackmail to obtain "mandate" which led to mobilising 28 Countries to attack Iraq. The real aim is to change the Government, depose or kill Hussein and replace him with a sorrogate or revert it into the Kingdom it was ^{from} 1921-1958, to make it easy for full exploitation of its vast oil resources. IS COMMUNISM A CRIME ?

The new world sing song consists of democracy and human rights. US and British allies in the Gulf states are absolute monarchies who appropriate the wealth of each country to absolute control of the monarch. No accountability to anybody. They are always held into ransom by spurious security reports about threat that Iraq is in possession of weapons of mass destruction. For nine years Iraq cannot sell its nature's gift. Karl maxx was from the West. The west went to the Americas and eliminated the indian aborigines who had lived there for 18 thousand years. 




I am sure the BBC deliberately embarks on mis-interpreting and mixing up communism and socialism/democracy and capitalism in the interest of the new alliance between Britain and United States of America for global domination.

The Greek city states first practised (and defined) democracy, but failed because it was within the confines of individual states, as "rule of the people by their own constitutionally elected representatives". In interaction between them, there was always clash of economic interests. They were farmers and merchants, constituted into trading colonies. They fought and took slaves for about 200 years and it "collapsed". That was period of Great Age of the rise and fall of Greece. Consequence of faulty practice of democracy in the period of "civilised" ignorance.

Britain is noted for its Parliamentary democracy from which the appellation "mother of parliaments" originated. Though it has a monarch who only reigns, and has no written constitution, the government is of the people by their constitutionally elected representatives. But it acquired colonies which became the Empire on which the sun never set. The thirteen colonies it created in North American realised that their political and economic rights were denied them. They fought and won to have "a government of the people by the people for the people" as defined by their hero, Abraham Lincoln. Remember the Bolton Massacre (1770), the Bolton Tea Party (1773) and Declaration of Independence (1776). Root cause of the revolt was economic. The ironies of democracy in practice!

The adjunct of the type of democracy in which a powerful developed, nation imposes trade terms on a weaker one is capitalism. So we have capitalist democracy. That is what operates in Colonial territories. Next to slavery. In a supposedly free undeveloped or developing country, it is neo-colonialism which is "the use of economic pressure by a powerful country to dominate a less developed one". For an Empire it is imperialism which is "systematic attempt to dominate weaker countries by political or economic means".
