BOMBING OF IRAQ IN DEFIANCE OF UN AND HUMANITY
AN APPEAL TO THE WORLD BY A HUMBLE NIGERIAN.

Since, the United States of America unilaterally assumed the duty of Police man of the world she has embarked on many dangerous adventures to promote American interests and values which in plain language is capitalism. And America is a Super-capitalist country. In the historic year of 1998, she has got a loyal partner. Her former colonial master; the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland. They entered a new political marriage during the tenure of Ronald Reagan, as US President and Margaret Thatcher as Prime Minister of Britain. Together they have forged a renewed concept of the pernicious doctrine of MIGHT IS RIGHT structured with the "bluff and bluster of a bully", reminiscent of Nazi Germany's turbulent aggressive policies that culminated in WORLD WAR II and propaganda which, with persistence, insistence and consistency vigour makes falsehood look like truth.

The recent bombing of Iraq for four days on the persistent orchestration of destroying, or preventing Saddam Hussein from manufacture of "Weapons of mass destruction" and from constituting, a threat to its neighbours are just part of the system. FRAUD AND FORCE. And this action taking place a few days to the Muslim holy month of Ramadan and the Christian holy birthday of Jesus Christ is Satanic.

It was carried out in contempt of world opinion and in defiance of the United Nations Security Council which had not discussed the UN Arms Inspectors report. More disgusting was the daring donation of about two hundred million dollars by the duo to arm Iraq opposition to topple Saddam Hussein government. This used to be an aspect of the covert operations of the American Central Intelligence Agency. But they now come to the open

This is also the period that General Augusto Pinochet, the dictator who overthrew the popularly, democratically elected Chilean government violently with US instigation, is fighting Court battle in London

for immunity to cover his seventeen years of terror. Under pressure from the US it appears the dictator is expecting reprieve as the very High Court of Britain has reversed its own decision for immunity from prosecution because he was head of State when he committed the serious offences.

Fifty years of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, Pinochet is a violator, a terrorist and anti every principles of democracy. This is a great friend of America whose President Clinton is still facing a trial for offences arising from sexual misadventure. You marvel at the practice of democracy and wonder at America's encouragement and installation of dictatorship in other countries.

The news of the bombing of US Embassies caught the world napping. How could it happen to America? The most powerful nation in the world with very sophisticated security gadgets and intelligence services. The immediate response was the bombing of targets in paralysed Afghanistan and war torn Sudan without any recourse to the United Nations. Terrorism against terrorism. Demonstration of MIGHT IS RIGHT.

The dust from this has not subsided before the US and UK embarked on bombing Iraq. The Kosovo (misadventure is still on with NATO, another group that is forcing itself to act as military arm of the UN, occupying parts of Yugoslavia. This, again headed by the U.S., was established in 1952 as a result of a military pact in 1949 between US, Britain, Canada, France, Benelux, Denmark, Norway, Ireland, Italy and Portugal, Greece and Turkey, joined in 1952. West Germany was brought in 1954. Of note is that Italy and Germany were (with Japan) allies in the war of 1939 to 1945.

To counter this, the WARSAW TREATY ORGANISATION was established in 1955 between Albania, Bulgaria, Czechoslovakia, East Germany, Hungary, Poland, Romania, Soviet Union. It was motivated by admission of West Germany into NATO. Thus allignment for the cold war was defined.

Apart from this being an appeal, it is also a warning and also to alert the world of the consequences of American global ambition. This ambition has some resemblance to the Hitler Nazi German ambition starting in the 1930s with a note of Germany's claim to Colonies.

This brings to mind the reported musing and regret of a Germany Pastor, Martin Niemöller quoted by Kofi Annan, Secretary General of the UN. The recent quote is in a Nigerian Newspaper, NATIONAL CONCORD of MONDAY December 14th, 1998. A survivor of the Nazi holocaust the Pastor said' "When the Nazis came looking for communists, I said nothing. I was not a communist. When they locked up the Social democrats, I said nothing. I was not a social democrat. When they came looking for the Jews, I said nothing. I was not a Jew. When they came looking for Catholics, I said nothing. I was not a Catholic. When they came looking for me, there was no one to protest".

The words are loud and clear enough. If because you are not Saddam Hussein or an Iraq national you say nothing in protest, your turn will come. The next target in that area (Arab world) is Muammar Gadafy and Libya. They fly the banners of Arab nationalism started by Abdel Nassar in 1952.

THE COLD WAR AND IDEOLOGICAL BACKGROUND

In the WORLD BOOK DICTIONARY published in America, 1979 edition, COLD WAR is defined as, "the contest for world leadership that began after WORLD WAR II between the Communist nations headed primarily by the Soviet Union and nations of the West headed principally by the United States."

In COLLINS CONCISE ENCYCLOPEDIA 1980 edition typeset in England and published in US, it, (Cold War) is defined as "economic and political rivalry between nations, without actual military conflict. Popularly used for post - WORLD WAR II struggle between Communist nations and the West.

These two definitions omit to mention the core of the great divide. Between Communism and West is ambiguous. The correct definition is between CAPITALISM and COMMUNISM. Because, like the Nazi information machine, the new West information machine, pitches communism against democracy as two opposites.

Let us research into books for the definitions of Democracy, capitalism and communism. It is very necessary to understand the direction the new self-imposed custodians of democratic practice are directing the world. So as not to fall to the same trap of Nazi Germany which led to the war that caused unprecedented mass destruction of humans and materials. While the Nazis employed inflammatory propaganda, directed by Goebbels, the Gestapo from 1933 combined with Hitler's SS in 1936 under Himmler, the US has taken full advantage of advance information technology to foil its own version of anything on the world in its interests and values. Apart from its numerous intelligence agencies, it created the Central Intelligence Agency.

The German Gestapo and SS carried out ruthless policies of investigation, torture, extermination, and infiltrated and destroyed organisations opposed to Nazism. All the energies were directed to forcing the world to a negotiating table and

speaking from a position of conqueror for redistribution of the world so that Germany could have the share proportionate to the "numbers, courage and worth of the nation".

From the period colonialism became fashionable and ownership of an empire was the apogee of imperialist power ambition, it was easy for Hitler to arouse the upper class, the capitalist class, in a struggle to "redress" the punishment inflicted on the Germans after defeat in WORLD WAR I. Consequently, all obstacles must be destroyed. With the "defeat" of the Soviet Union in the COLD WAR, through what I will refer to in boxing parlance as hitting below the belt, the US with Britain on tow is now poised to rule the world by destroying what the world has achieved through the United Nations Organisations for the past fifty three years. It is also bent to reverse the gains of independence in third world countries.

DEMOCRACY, CAPITALISM, COMMUNISM

The very leap forward in information technology is being seriously abused. It is being effectively used to dis-inform, mis-inform and for brain washing and mind bending. So I have decided to use THE WAVERLY ENCYCLOPEDIA, compiled and printed in Great Britain in the fifties.

DEMOCRACY: Rule of the people by their own constitutionally elected representatives. Term originally used by Aristotle. Abraham Lincoln's phrase "government of the people, by the people for the people" is often taken as an acceptable definition. Its form may vary in detail from one democratic state to another. But four essential tests of democratic governments are:

- (1) That it should, at regular intervals, submit itself to the test of free election by the whole adult community;
- (2) That it should allow freedom for the expression of views in opposition to those of the prevailing party;
- (3) That all persons, whether private or public officials, should be equally accountable for their acts before the law.

tribunal;

(4) That its judiciary should ^{be} independent and impartial.

CAPITALISM: System of private ownership of capital, especially of the concentration of capital in the hands of a relatively small number of people. Societies under a fully developed capitalism are distinguished by private property, free enterprise, and competition with profit as their motive, and free choice on the part of the consumer.

From mid-19th century the freedom of the individual capitalist was gradually reduced, by state intervention, influence of collectivist ideas (socialism, communism), and by growth of monopolies and combines. In some countries, e.g U.S.S.R, individual capitalism has been supplanted by State capitalism. In others, as in Great Britain, and in lesser extent in the U.S.A., it has developed into a mixed economy, with State and private enterprise working side by side.

COMMUNISM: Theory and political creed of common ownership of all property and means of production. Until the 19th century communism and socialism were used as identical terms. Two differing ideas on political action to secure equality have emerged. Socialism (evolutionary), and communism (revolutionary socialism), advocating class-warfare and violence. Communist doctrine was consolidated by Karl Marx and propagated by his friend Friedrich Engels. Modern Communism is based on the Communist Manifesto (1848) and other writings of these two, and of Lenin and Stalin. It postulates a struggle between the classes as the main force in political history, with the bourgeoisie and proletariat as the current opposing groups. The "dictatorship of the proletariat" would ensue, other classes would be eradicated, and a classless society emerge.

Here we see clearly that the anti-thesis of capitalism is communism. Democracy predates the two. But democracy started having problems right from the Greek City States. Apart from conflicts in

dealing with each other, slaves from the armed conflicts were not entitled to enjoy what was democracy and the city states. Constant conflicts weakened them considerably and collapsed under the MIGHT IS RIGHT heels of emerging Roman Empire.

Between that period and Abraham Lincoln's "acceptable" definition of democracy many thinkers, philosophers and reformers traversed the earth alongside monarchies, empires and religions. There was the Roman Empire that virtually ruled the world. It was even bestowed with HOLINESS (HOLY ROMAN EMPIRE), even with gross injustice covered up with military might. It was at the height of the inglorious glory that the first monotheist in history came on the stage - Jesus Christ. The core of his message was the fatherhood of God and brotherhood of man. In short, the equality of man before God. For which he was killed. Rome with all its holiness finally fell under the might of the so called Barbarian Odoacer. Europe was divided into barbarian Kingdoms in the 5th century.

THE UNITED STATES AND BRITAIN GLOBAL AMBITION

When Ceasar, Roman ruler visited Britain about 55 B.C. his impression of the land and people in these words: "As in Gaul, there is timber of every description except beech and fir. Most of the inland inhabitants do not sow corn, but live on milk and flesh and are clad with skins. All the British, indeed, dye themselves with wood, which occasions a bluish colour and thereby have a more terrible appearance in fight".

Colonised by Rome till the 5th century, Britain went through many stages of growth and turbulence. The WAR OF ROSES destroyed feudalism (1455-85) and replaced it with a new mercantile class. Strife, both internal and with Europe notwithstanding, the 17th, 18th and 19th centuries saw the emergence of a United Kingdom (with boost from the Industrial Revolution) at the head of an empire covering vast areas in Europe, Asia, America, Africa and Australasia. Despite the set back caused by excise of the thirteen American colonies (American war of independence) in 1776, exploration, annexations and wars, she entered the 20th century still atop of an

empire on which the sun never set.

American statesman, 1743-1826, Thomas Jefferson, wrote the American declaration of Independence, published on 4th July 1776. He was president 1801-9. The series of events preceeding this declaration and independence inspired colonial subjects of European powers in the Western Hemisphere to start agitation for independence. The new America readily obliged; alongside its own desire to expand. Consequarntly, when the Concert of Europe, at the Congress of Verona in 1822 discussed the re-conquest of Spanish Colonies that had gone under the "protection" of the US, the then President, James Monroe, propounded a fundamental principle of American foreign policy to Check European powers in the "new world", which he sent in a message to Congress on December 2, 1823:

"In the war of European powers in matters relating to themselves we have never taken any part, nor does it comport with our policy so to do. It is only when our rights are invaded or seriously menaced that we resent injuries or make preparation for our defence. With the movements in this hemisphere we are of necessity more immediately connected, and by causes which must be obvious to all enlightened and impartial observers the political system of the allied powers is essentially different in this respect from that of America.... We owe it, therefore to candour and to amicable relations existing between the United States and those powers to declare that we should consider any attempt on their part to extend their system to any portion of this hemisphere as dangerous to our peace and safety."

"With the existing colonies or dependencies of any European we have not interiered and shall not interfere. But with the Governments who have declared their independence and maintained it, and whose independence we have, on great consideration and on just principles, acknowledged, we could not view any interposition for purpose of oppressing them, or controlling in any other manner their destiny,

by any European power in any other light than as the manifestation of an unfriendly disposition toward the United States."

The main import of the doctrine was America for Americans. This was after more States had been added to the thirteen at Independence either by conquest or "negotiated" purchase. It firmly closed the door against European powers from establishing any colony in any part of American continents.

Britain and France, worried about the economic expansion of the United States, attempted to create a balance of power by penetrating into Argentina, California, Texas and Oregon. The US reacted in 1845 by enlarging the Monroe doctrine. James Polk, US President then, said the US could not look on while Europeans interfered with the "independent actions of this continent."

US annexed Texas in defiance of Mexico. After failing to coerce Mexico to sell California to her, she resorted to force, and Mexico was defeated. The forced armistice ceded Mexican territory covering California, Nevada, Utah, Arizona, New Mexico, Parts of Wyoming, Colorado, Kansas and Oklahoma to the US. Britain and France made another attempt in 1861 to carve out colony in Mexico. The US intervened swiftly, captured the head of the expedition, Archduke Maximilian, an Austrian, executed him and reinstated the deposed Juarez, a US favourite.

While the British Empire was built up through direct colonisation, the US built its own sphere of exploitation through economic penetration which later assume the name neo-colonialism. And they were supposed to be democracies. The slave trade was also accommodated when Africans were shipped out in chains to work in plantations.

In simple definition colonialism is the habitual acquisition and exploitation of colonies for the benefit of the mother country. Neo-Colonialism is the use of economic pressure by a powerful country to dominate a less developed one.

the two are the bedrock that earns the odious appellation of IMPERIALISM which is defined as the founding, development and maintenance of an empire, a systematic attempt to dominate weaker countries by political or economic means. It is the highest stage of capitalism. It must therefore be qualified as capitalist democracy.

This situation became more pronounced after the Industrial revolution spread to other countries and markets are needed to source raw materials, and sell finished products by developed industrial countries. As we had people with human feelings who championed the campaign against slave trade, notably William Wilberforce, so other people emerged to tell the world that it is equally evil against humanity for countries to exploit weaker countries.

SOCIALISM, SOCIALIST THEORIES AND COMMUNISM

Human experiences on this planet, EARTH, for ages have led to processes of ideas to change human society. The evolution and practice of capitalism especially after the Industrial Revolution with carryover of slavery and colonialism as legitimate practices, and other excesses of man's inhumanity to man, especially in exploitation, socialism and socialist theories emerged.

The definition, according to CHAMBER'S ENCYCLOPAEDIA, revised and reprinted in 1970 by International Learning Systems Corporation Ltd., London, is 'Socialism is a body of teaching and practice resting upon the belief that most social evils are due to excessively unequal distribution of material resources; and that these evils can be cured by the transference, gradual or immediate, total or partial, of the ownership of property and of the means of production, exchange and distribution from private to public control.

France played a leading role in reviving the concept of socialism in theory and practice in linking communism with the semi-communist constitution of ancient Sparta and the writings of Plato. Many thinkers took the stage in France in the 18th century and communism took concrete shape and entry into political voca-

Francois Noel Babeup a French revolutionary led a group in 1797 that really wanted to establish an early state of communism. They were betrayed by one of their members. Arrests followed, and the ring leaders executed

Apart from the UTOPIA of Thomas More with a concept of an ideal state ordered by reason in the 16th century, plethora of ideas emanated from all over Europe. But undoubtedly acclaimed as the "most celebrated and influential of all modern socialist thinkers is Karl Marx who was acknowledged to have "created the most lasting body of coherent socialist doctrine, and based on international organisation with revolutionary aims upon it".

This doctrine he began and exhaustively dealt with in many written works, he termed scientific socialism with active collaboration of his friend, Friedrich Engels. They co-compiled and published in 1848 the COMMUNIST MANIFESTO. The Communism attached to it was borrowed principally from France where it was explicitly used early in the 19th century. In simple interpretation, it is for a world planned economy in which the oppressed of the world, the proletariat, always in vast majority should rise up at a time and overthrow their oppressors, always in minority, and establish a new world order. It was a tall dream, but it was out of deep concern for humanity. Not any selfish or national interest. Marx and Engels were Germans who found no favour with their Country. Marx died in 1883. Engels died in 1895.

CAPITALIST DEMOCRACY VERSUS SOCIALIST DEMOCRACY

But their works lived and still live on. While it haunted people who were always in the minority, living in stinking affluence or absolute monarchies, it started a revolution which culminated in the success of the October Socialist revolution in Russia in 1917 which overthrew the feudal Czarist Government with its empire. The Socialists dissolved the empire and freed all the colonies. Thus we had the first Socialist (NOT COMMUNIST) country in the world,

led by Vladimir Lenin born in 1870, died 1924.

Right from 1917, the capitalist countries with their chains of colonial territories became jittery and feel threatened, despite the claim to democracy. By 1922 Bylorussia and Ukraine had joined the Russian Socialist Republic to found what became

> Internationally known and recognised as UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS.

It must be noted that at the success of the October 1917 revolution, the new socialist Government withdrew from the 1914-1918 war which it proclaimed as imperialist war. That decision discomfited what was then known as the allied and associated powers led by France, UK, (deceptively) British Empire, Russia and later the USA. It also included lesser states then as Belgium, Serbia, Montenegro, Japan, Portugal, Italy, Romania, and funny enough, Liberia, China, Brazil, Guatemala. The opposing group known as the Central powers consisted of Germany, Austria-Hungary, Turkey, and Bulgaria.

The great lesson from the young Socialist Government pullout from the war on the excuse that it was an imperialist war, is that the so called Western democracies are a deceit. It also gave a picture of the working of a capitalist democracy which accommodated slave trade from the 15th century until it was abolished later in the 19th century. What of colour bar that replaced slavery? What of neo-colonialism that took over from colonialism that was part of Empires? What of absolute monarchies that appropriate the wealth of a country to the exclusive custody of "royal" families who live in extreme affluence?

In the same year 1922 that saw the advent on world map of UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS, there was a Conference in Genoa. The Soviet Union delegates were promised that their country would be assisted to repair the ravages of war from which they withdrew in 1917 and damages in the civil war (which the

(most instigated) but won by the Bolsheviks on condition that they gave up plans for socialism which the delegates refused.

Then followed the 1925 Locarno, Switzerland, Treaty which brought France, Britain, Belgium, Italy and Germany against Russia. This gang up against the young State leaked through a statement by a British Cabinet Minister who said:

"The solidarity of Christian civilization is necessary to stem the most sinister growth that has arisen in European history....

Locarno means that so far as the present government of Germany is concerned, it is detached from Russia and is throwing its lot with the Western Party".

It was now convenient to invoke the Christian religion to bring in Germany to the fold against socialist Russia. But the Treaty of Versailles which altered political boundaries radically in Europe and overseas colonial territories against Germany principally and its allies remained in place. This laid the foundation of events that led to WORLD WAR II which did not consider Christian civilization in alignment of forces. But for the great error of judgement by Nazi Germany to have, without warning, invaded the Soviet Union in 1939 in violation of the Non-Aggression pact between them, the war could not have ended in 1945, or in favour of the allies. It was also a testimony to the potentials of socialist power.

Instead of being an inspiration to mankind in search of peace and prosperity, there was a gang up against USSR. The cold war emerged despite the existence of the United Nations Organisation from 1945. It was giving all sorts of names. But from the 1922 three constituent Units (Russia, Byelorussia and Ukraine) Union it had become fifteen states in 1940. Together they fought on the side of the allies to defeat the greatest threat to world peace in this century. The three strongest nations that emerged on the leadership stage after the war were Britain, the United States of America and the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics whose leaders were Winston Churchill, Franklin Delano Roosevelt and Joseph Stalin.

respectively. Together they sat in Yalta a town in USSR in Allied Conference February 1945 to resolve post - world war II fate of Germany and agreed on founding of the United Nations. Britain sat on top of an Empire made up of colonies, Dominions and Commonwealth all over the world. The United States was lording it over the former European colonies in the Western hemisphere through economic domination later known as neo-colonialism. The USSR had been in isolation and brought into international limelight by its exploits during the war.

Churchill lost the Premiership election in Britain in 1945.

Clement Attlee, Labour Party, took over. Roosevelt died same year.

Harry S. Truman became President. Stalin lived on till 1953. Meanwhile, Dwight Eisenhower, Chief of Allied Forces in North Africa (1942-1943), supreme commander of Allied invasion of Europe (1944), Army Chief of Staff (1945-1948), Commander of NATO Forces (1950-1952), USA President (1953-1961), started fostering anti-communist alliances in South East Asia and Latin America even from the middle of the war because ripples of achievements in the USSR were spreading. By the time the war ended soldiers from colonial countries who took part, especially from British Empire saw light and joined agitations for independence in their different countries.

It is a historical fact that a developed capitalist country cannot survive without overseas markets to source for raw materials and sell finished products. To buy at lowest price and sell at highest price respectively, and to maintain it, a colonial system must be introduced which was the practice by colonial powers all over the world. When America fought its way into independence in 1776, also forced its way by war, annexation, or purchase to increase from thirteen original states at independence, fought the civil war and became highly developed capitalist state, the need for outside markets became a necessity. These were readily available within its Western Hemisphere as earlier explained by driving all European

colonial powers away. To those former colonies they were happy to be assisted to be free. But they later found themselves economically subordinated and dependent on America.

The ripples from the new Soviet Union became a storm in South and Latin American countries. Marxist revolutionaries doted the whole area. So also in South East Asia generally, the middle East, Arab countries, Africa etc. Just any where there was any form of domination.

THE UNITED STATES AND GLOBAL AMBITION

As far as I am concerned present day America has no history. The original inhabitants of North America before Christopher Columbus discovery, were Red Indians in thirteen groups of recognised families. In the South the families of tribes are much more difficult to classify as they grouped in the mountainous region. The first settlers were believed to have come from the Asiatic part of what became to be known as the Soviet Union, travelling through Alaska about 18,000 years ago. They were Mongoloid people. They had developed a high degree of native civilization. The Mexican and Peruvian had advanced in architecture. They had copper, gold and Bronze. The Mayas, Aztecs and Incas were the first American Indians to reach a high peak of independent civilization which influenced others in the two Americas.

Spain was the most powerful country of the world at that period in history. It was therefore the first to enter that hemisphere and established colonies after ruthlessly crushing the Aztecs. That was the beginning of the decline ^{of/} Red Indian civilisation. Portugal followed. England with the officially sponsored pirates, Francis Drake and John Hawkins, did illegal business with Spanish colonies and attacked and robbed their ships on the high seas. The Dutch and French followed. They fought against themselves to steal and plunder the tremendous wealth in the new land and forced the owners

employed by it. The Act also empowered the Director to bring one hundred aliens a year secretly to the United States above the normal immigration laws. The Director was given wide powers to spend money without regard to regulation governing expenditure of government funds.

The funds of the Agency are incorporated in a very secret annual budget which is not subject to scrutiny. This Agency spent about 1,400 million pounds sterling every year accounted for by a certificate signed by the Director. You know the equivalent of that amount now.

In sponsoring the Act it was revealed that "Men in this Agency frequently loose their lives. Several have already done so, and not under very pretty circumstances. If we force the Agency to have record of vouchers, foreign agents could pick up information as to the identity of our agents and what they were doing".

It was so powerful. It included many other units and agencies as well as individuals that appear outwardly to be a normal part of the conventional government. It even had business firms and institutions that are seemingly private. Diplomats, journalists, members of all professions and tourists were recruited. The covert operations cover influencing election results, overthrow of legitimate, democratic governments not favourable to American interests and values. In 1950. Republican Senator for Wisconsin (1947-1957) raised an alarm in 1950 that the State Department had been infiltrated by communists. It was a wild witch hunt that rocked America until he was censured in 1954. He was Senator MacCarthy.

When the CIA activities became too appalling. Harry Truman who created it in 1947 wrote in a newspaper in 1963: "I never had any thought that when I set up the CIA that it would be injected into peacetime cloak and - dagger operations. Some of the complications and embarrassment that I think we have experienced are in

part attributable to the fact that this quiet intelligence arm of the President has been so removed from its intended role that it is being interpreted as a symbol of sinister and mysterious foreign intrigue and a subject for cold war enemy progaganda". It has even assumed more powers since Reagan's Presidency.

I have just heard on BBC (British Broadcasting Corporation) that President Clinton is arranging communication between the US and Cuba people, sidetracking the government. This is in continuation of subversion of the Castro regime. In this circumstance, we should use Cuba as an example of US neo-colonialist policies in South and Latin America.

Arawak Indians were inhabitants of Cuba when Christopher Columbus discovered it in 1492. It automatically became Spanish Colony. The American struggle and ultimate independence in 1776 influenced agitations in Cuba. Manuel de Céspedes independence movement peaked in 1868. The US intervened in 1898 by sending a battleship to "Protect American interests". Then there was war between US and Spain. The US Congress passed a resolution in April 1898 declaring the independence of Cuba. Spain was defeated and Cuba became American "protectorate" in 1899 in the name of independence. As usual things went through changes until American best friend, Batista, emerged after a military coup in 1933 and became President in 1940.

Corruption and repression trailed his government, as it is usual in all neo-colonialist states dominated by US. Agitation drove him to exile in US in 1945. He was reinstated after another US inspired coup in 1952. Corruption and discontent continued unabated which led to his overthrow by Fidel Castro in 1959. He fled to Dominican Republic where another US sponsored dictator ruled.

It is significant to mention that the original Arawak Indians had been completely wiped out before abolition of slave trade. Over

four centuries of Spanish rule and period of American "Protectorate" independence, Cuba only became a holiday resort to Americans for frolics, frivolities and debauchery, where, like other West Indian resorts, "both mother and daughter worked for the Yankee dollars". The communist (it is infact socialist) revolution of 1959 headed by Fidel Castro revolutionised all aspects of life in Cuba within twenty years. Education, Health and Child care, agriculture, employment, science and technology etc. took very impressive leap forward. The United Nations records acknowledged the achievements. All made quickly possible by assistance from the USSR in line with its policy of peaceful competition with US in assistance to developing countries.

But capitalist democracy has its limitations. So despite the embarrassment of failure of the Bay of pigs adventure, thirty years of economic blockage, several attempts to kill Castro and nearly ten years of no assistance from former USSR, Cuba lives on, come sun, come shine, come deluge of anti-Castro electronic and print propaganda, come provocations from US armed and trained Cuba exiles, Cuba and Castro still exist. Now in desperation Clinton wants to start inciting Cubans at home directly by a show of MIGHT IS RIGHT and by FRAUD and FORCE.

In Arab and Middle East, countries where the oil market had provided very comfortable havens of explotation through the rogue absolute monarchies who appropriate the vast oil wealth to their families, the first storm was when Abdel Nasser struck in 1952 and overthrew King Farouk and abolished monarchy in 1953. Arab nationalism cord was sounded and started to take root. Flirtation with socialism led to nationalisation of Swez Canal in which Britain had controlling shares in the managing company (Swezeanal Co.). Britain, Israel and France Invaded Egypt. Troops from France and Britain occupied canal area. Through pressure from the United States invading force were replaced by UN emergency.

force. USSR influence surfaced to help Egypt to build Aswan High Dam in the Sixties (completed 1970) a considerable enlargement to the existing one completed in 1902 under British rule. Anwar Sadat became President after Nasser's death in 1970. US was able to get into Egyptian politics by not overtly taking sides in the hostilities and thus winning Sadat's confidence to get the Soviet Union influence gradually out of Egypt. Today Egypt is highly indebted to the US and cannot take any definite stand in Arab politics that will "offend" the US.

Iraq caught the bug of Arab nationalism in 1958 when it overthrew the thirty seven years old kingdom in a military coup. Then followed the formation of Ba'th Socialist Party. Being very rich oil country, producing six percent of world total (1979 figure) there was enough resources to develop. No loopholes for looting. Land - distribution reforms initiated in 1959 was consolidated by the Agricultural Act of 1970. Rural cooperative associations spread all over the country leading to improved productivity and equitable distribution of income.

Though oil is the major income earner, other non-oil products improved considerably. Education leaped forward. It was planned to eradicate illiteracy by 1980. Many students were sent to Europe and America for graduate and post graduate training. The war with Iran, 1981-1988 disrupted further plans. National plans for 1965-1970, 1970-1975 and 1975-1980 took care of all round development in the economy and provided for expansion of welfare services. Social system changed drastically from the past rigid ethnic, linguistic, religious and economic divisions under a monarchical dispensation. Of late was the decline of the landed aristocracy.

The eight years Iraq-Iran war was more of an American war, the US was a great friend of the Shah Pahlavi of Iran (of famous PEACOCK throne) who was forced to abdicate through Ayatollah Khomeini's led revolution in January 1979. A Regency and Supreme Army Council was established. Khomeini arrived on February 1, 1979. There was a referendum on April 1, 1979 which gave him power to declare an Islamic Republic that had a clear anti-US and anti-West tone. Western educated and many Iranians fled the country. The US Embassy was occupied by supporters of the revolution and seized Sixty Six US citizens. Fourteen were later released while the rest were held hostage until January 20, 1981 after a failed commando rescue attempt and serious negotiations.

Iraq invaded Iran in September 1980. Whether it was in sympathy with the US and anti-Islamic regime Iranians, or out of fear of or aversion to such neighbour, is still not clear. But the US was very happy and it made a lot of contribution in weapons to Iraq. One would therefore want to examine very very carefully why America has now become such a bitter enemy to Iraq and especially its leader, Saddam Hussein over the invasion of Kuwait two years after the war instead of a rebuke or a censure. After eight years of war, two years of US-led Desert Storm of twenty eight countries is devastating bombardment to "drive Iraq out of Kuwait" which was part of Iraq, eight years of UN sanctions and arms destruction and inspection that should not last longer than a year, where comes the money to produce arms of mass destruction and threat, to neighbours?

The irony: Iran is an Islamic Republic; Iraq is a country dominated by adherents of Islam, but its economic, political and social policies are guided by socialism, Kuwait is an Islamic Sheikdom. And the US is supposed to be a Christian - inclined secular nation. The bombing co-traveller, Britain, is a Christian State (the Queen is head of the Church).

By choosing to embark on bombing missions during a week to the Holy month of Islam Ramadan and to the birth of Jesus Christ where do we place these two nations? And where do democracy and Human Rights fit in when only two of them took the decision without authority from the UN?

There are more to these pretences, brutality, fraud and force. Iraq is bounded in the North by Turkey on the East by Iran, on the South East by the Persian Gulf, on the West by Syria and Jordan and on the South by Kuwait and Saudi Arabia. The Kurds in the North have some area belonging to Turkey and parts of Syria and Iran.

The area within the territory of Iraq has been declared non-flight zone by Britain and America. Same as the South where there are some Muslim fundamentalists with different orientation whom the two countries are "protecting" against the legitimate territorial owner - IRAQ. It is Iraq oil they are after. Iraq wants to carry on its development stalled by the war with Iran.

On the line of hate by Britain and America is Libya, another oil rich Arab country where American friend, king. Idris, was over thrown by its leader, Gaddafi in 1959. They bombed two Libyan cities in 1986 with intention to kill Gaddafi on false accusation.

They are still raging and roaring about two Libya security officers whom they accused of bombing the aircraft that crashed over Lockerbie in Scotland in 1988. They want them to be surrendered so they can grill them to "confess" that they were sent by Gaddafi whom they want to get rid of and reverse all the good work he had done for his people and country. Same as they want to do in Iraq and instal robots like Boris Yeltsin, President of Russia, who was taken from hospital recently to sign sack letters of three of his senior officials not in the good books of the West. He went back to

Hospital bed immediately. His doctors are mostly from America and Germany. Gaddafi's greatest offence was closure of American Wheelus Field base used to ferry mercenaries to Congo to help instal Mobutu in 1965.

Prominent among the allies of Britain and America in the Middle East and Arab States are absolute Kingdoms, Saltanates and Sheikdoms whose vast oil resources are exploited for the benefit of the royal families and foreign interests while the common majority live on the crumbs from the tables. Far cry from DEMOCRACY and Human Rights they champion so vociferously.

In Africa, the struggle took the form of wind of change acknowledged by the colonial powers who feared nationalism as they feared communism and socialism. So when Patrice Lumumba, through a democratic election became Premier of the former Belgian Congo, CIA inspired internal struggle flared up. He invited the United Nations to mediate. His friendship with Kwame Nkrumah, Ghana nationalist and Pan-Africanist and friend of the Soviet Union, was not acceptable to American led Western powers.

Wheelus Field base acquired by America from King Idris of Libya was used to assemble and ferry mercenaries to Congo which Lumumba renamed Democratic Republic of Congo. It was a CIA operation which led to the murder of Lumumba and the sabotage of the plane that crashed and killed the Secretary General of the United Nations, Dag Hammarskjold, in 1961. Hammarskjold was after justice, but he paid for it with his life.

After a lot of intrigues, skirmishes, resulting into many loss of lives, and manipulations, Mobutu, a Sergeant in Congo army, but a choice and stooge of America, became President in 1965. He was a dictator and looter for thirty two years. He sold and consigned vast mineral rich lands to Western Companies and Congo was the base for supply of arms, money and materials to anti-nationalist organisations (like UNITA) in Southern Africa.

Also to prop up Apartheid. Kabila is a Lumumba disciple of grassroot democracy.

It is interesting that seven months after that ruthless dictator, Mobutu, was overthrown by Kabila, the cry of democracy and human rights was being rammed down the throats of the new nationalists. Kabila has been the target of attacks. He is a dictator. He is everything evil. The countries that assisted him to drive Mobutu out now turn round to arm rebels to invade Congo after visits of US President Clinton (to Uganda) and the UN Secretary General to Rwanda.

Because Angola and Zimbabwe come to the assistance of Kabila, the UNITA has resumed fighting in Angola and Mugabe is under fire at home and abroad. Congo Brazzaville is boiling. South Africa is still enjoying the acclaim of post Apartheid democracy.

President Mandela has been decorated with many awards and honours by those who a few years back called him a terrorist. But it is a tragedy that in South Africa, unemployment is on the rise as well as violent and non-violent crimes, rape, drug addiction and trafficking and murders, because, while political Apartheid is dead, economic Apartheid remains. The economy of the country is largely controlled by whites. That is the "glory" of capitalist democracy. Less than fifty persons control the wealth.

The year (1948) Apartheid was established was the same year of Universal Declaration of Human Rights by the United Nations. The same year Britain took a step forward into socialism by nationalising British Railways and the British Electricity Industry. New Federal Constitution in Malay. Burma became a Republic.

Independence Act for Ceylon. Gandhi assassinated a year after Indian independence. Earl Mountbatten succeeded by Indian, Rajagopalachari, as Governor General. Israeli State proclaimed. Republic of (South) Korea proclaimed (US "protectorate"). Britain

ended bread rationing. Communists formed Socialist Government in Czechoslovakia. UN Mediator for Palestine, Count Bernadotte assassinated. Communist Manifesto by Marx and Engels was 100 years old. In 1998, there is confusion everywhere.

It was the same year (1948) that my employers', a leading British company, discovered my clandestine involvement in the nationalist struggle and that I was the writer of an article in 1946 (with a pen name) giving details of the part I played in reception of a delegation led by Late Dr. Nnamdi Azikiwe when he visited the station where I worked as part of nationwide tour to highlight the abnoxious clauses in the constitution of 1946 introduced by the British colonial government. I was rebuked, advised and promised a high position if I behaved. I could not. Three years later, (1951) I left voluntarily.

From then I started writing with my name openly. I refused to be in full time politics because I knew I could better serve the country in the economic aspect with the practical knowledge I had acquired. As a stop-gap I joined a newly established newspaper (since defunct) where I took care of the accounts section and maintained a column until I got myself into business as an exporter for thirty years until I got incapacitated by two accidents in 1982 and 1983.

Being in business gave me an independent base of income. I wrote articles and took part in politics seeking no elective posts or publicity. I also got involved in International politics through the International peace movement started by Frederic and Irene Joliot-Curie, French atomic physicists, who fore-saw the dangers of leaving atomic weapons in the hands of governments (politicians). That led to founding of World Council of Peace (later World Peace Council). I was the first Nigerian to be a member. And I founded and presided over a local peace movement which was banned by the military.

From my very young age my father, who was one of the young men who escaped from Benin in 1897 (when the British expedition bombarded Benin and took the King to exile) used to tell me stories of his experiences. He was rescued by some white (English) traders who took him up. From them he knew how to read and write and was the first Christian (Anglican) in his family. I stop there as I am not writing a biography.

All over Africa there is poverty, there is conflict, there is hunger, there is corruption. A continent blessed with abundance in natural resources. When American President, Clinton, visited the continent last year, his mission was "resolution of conflicts". For this he sent experts to some countries to train and arm local people. We have seen the result in all those countries. Unrest galore.

People thought the exclusion of Nigeria from the trip was deliberate, giving as reason the repressive government of late Sani Abacha. But when, still on African soil, he said Abacha could compete for the Presidency of Nigeria. The message was very clear. More so when the democratically elected M.K.O Abiola, in 1993, was languishing in jail. When Abacha died suddenly, the "democratic countries" were so worried that Abiola may become President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria that their emissaries stormed Nigeria, and at last the "American wonder" conjured the coincidence that made Abiola die in the hands of their powerful delegation, of "natural causes".

It reminds me of the condolence delegation that visited Abiola Family after the assassination of his wife, Kudirat, from the Federal Government which specifically put the blame on "armed bandits". Which investigation in Nigeria would give a contrary verdict? Just like expert autopsy on Abiola confirmed that he died of natural causes. But, thanks to Dr. Yakassai, we now know better.

DECOLONISATION AND RECOLONISATION

When Jimmy Carter became American President in 1977, he was appalled by the record of the internal and International evil activities of the Central Intelligence Agency. He took swift action to clip its wings considerably.

Immediately Reagan became President in 1981 he revived the CIA and gave it more powers than before. Another organ, THE HERITAGE, with experts in running any country, organisation or individual down in blackmail, forgery, coercion, intimidation and falsehood, was upstaged. They have been most active every where worldwide.

Reagan is an ultra-conservative American. To him America comes first before any nation. This was reflected in his inaugural speech. The blacks are not more than slaves. Africans should not rule themselves. The Arabs are Barbarians. The Soviet Union is an evil empire which must be pulled down. Nationalism or regional groupings must give way. Communists, Socialists and Marxists must be destroyed physically and seventy years achievements must be obliterated.

He got some special THINK THANK to mark out the strategies. They targeted the Soviet Union and Nigeria specifically. The USSR played very significant roles in liberation/independence struggles, in economic, industrial, scientific and educational assistance to third world countries. Records of the United Nations will testify to many resolutions sponsored in favour of third world countries and for world peace.

Nigeria is the largest black country in the world and the hope, until recently, of the blacks in the diaspora. A successful Nigeria would influence all Africa and beyond.

By mid-eighties the CIA, the Heritage and the open government had got Mikhail Gorbachev and spotted Babangida.

US concentrated on Gorbachev while Britain worked on Nigeria where they found Babangida to be very ambitious and very cooperative. By the time Gorbachev realised that he had betrayed his country, Reggan had completed his second term. An equally anti-Soviet George Bush had become President. America trained Russian immigrants, CIA agents and Heritage experts had entrenched themselves in the Soviet system and in Moscow. By the time Gorbachev refused to discard socialism, they had got Boris Yetsin, a vodka addict who had been sacked as the Secretary of Moscow Communist Party, to replace him and forced him on the throne without a Constitution in 1991/92. They arrested three leading Soviet figures in the political set-up, the parliament and head of the Red Army.

Then the Constitution came out in 1993 from the "American Wonder" bag of tricks. Yetsin was "ordered" to dissolve the Soviet Union which the Parliament rejected. Members refused to leave the building. George Bush asked Yetsin to get the army to flush them out. Tanks and bullets went into action killing many and damaging the building extensively.

Thus an American government headed by a Russian robot was installed in the heart of the once second most powerful country in the world. When journalists asked George Bush how he pulled out the feat he said "we have our people there". The head was cut off a solid union of 15 republics within which were 20 autonomous regions and over 10 autonomous areas. Contrary to the disinformation being dished out that ethnic problems contributed to the collapse of the Soviet Union, ethnic groups and stages of development were well taken care of.

All of them are in disarray. But American business concerns have penetrated, privatising all socialist structures at give away prices with private capitals and IMF (International Monetary Fund) "loans". The IMF was supposed to be a UN Agency established in 1945 to facilitate discharge of International debts and by enabling

member States to buy foreign currency. But it has become an American agency of usury. The fund is limitless, controlled by US Congress, the more it gives out with its "conditionalities" the more profit it makes and the poorer the recipients become.

In Kazakhastan alone there are one hundred American oil companies apart from those from other Western countries. What were things taken for granted like free education, free health care, full employment are now no more. Real human tragedy now prevails all over the former territories of the Soviet Union. Three years salary arrears, cold in regions where it is 60° below zero in winter kill old and young. Corruption, drug addiction, gang wars, assassinations, mafia menace and crimes that were not in the former Soviet Union are the order of the day. Civil wars, religions conflicts in the Muslim States of Central Asia, break away regions in the Russian Federation and conflicts in Georgia, Armenia etc, add more to the misery. The world is set back by a century by US ambition.

I visited all the republics of the Union some of them two or three times. Same as all the Socialist countries in Europe as well as the Western capitalist countries except Norway, where I had business connections. The difference were so clear between Socialist democracy and capitalist democracy.

The United States announced the first balanced, even surplus, Budget for the first time in thirty years. It is at the expense of the dying and suffering of over two hundred million people in the former Soviet Union who constituted one sixth of the world who are derailed from a strong Socialist planned economy to the slavery of a capitalist economy.

In Nigeria the first indication of Babangida's mission was the introduction of Structural Adjustment Programme, sequel to acceptance of IMF loan which was indirect opposition to the recommendations of the Political Bureau which he set up.

His utterances of "enduring democracy", "we dont know who will succeed us, but we know who will not succeed us", and his undertaking to fight radicals and extremists are echo from the valley of capitalist democracy tutelage.

The unending transition for eight years was a super structure of deceits and strategies. Being from a minority area of the North, to win the Northern oligarchy, he played on the North/South dichotomy along the lines conceived by the British and the wishes of late Sardauna. The North came first, so he embarked on some annoying Northernisation policies which had adverse effect on efficiency, eventually leading to the collapse of many public utilities from which the orchestration of privitisation rent the air.

The sum total was that Babangida wanted to be in complete control of Nigeria. The Press, the Legislature, the judiciary, Trade Unions, Professional Associations, just every thing. Pauperisation of politicians was to make the National assembly surbordinate to him by the line he would manipulate himself to the Presidency. Corruption institutionalised. Bomb introduced. His regime was to be like that of Augusto Pinochet planted on the Chilean people by US Central Intelligence Agency, which he studied closely.

Thatcher's Britain had to reward him in 1989 with the Knight of the order of the bath thinking that by the steps he had taken so far, he would succeed. Perhaps it was a co-incident that Margaret Thatcher declared shortly after Babangida came to power, and Reagan appeared to have penetrated the Soviet system, that she would make every Briton a capitalist. The same Knighthood was bestowed on Ronald Reagan whose successor, George Bush, was able to complete the job "collapse of Communism".

Babangida's successor, Abacha, after reaching Aso Rock, saw many of the plans already in place which fired his ambition. The report of the Pius Okigbo panel opened his eyes to how extensive one could divert Government funds and how one could operate. These combined with instinct of greed and brutality that could be covered up with all the available forces of coercion, all available means of elimination of opponents and set ups, he dived head-long ruthlessly all round. But the debauchery corner of his bravado gained the upper hand and he expired on the 8th of June.

Despite the theatricals of America and Britain, they were aware of everything that was happening which suited their global ambition to rule a pauperised world.

The death of Abacha threw a wedge on their Nigerian Front. They set to work immediately Abiola had gone. They have overwhelmed General Abdusalami Abubakar who is now caught between them and their local fronts. And the only way they can maintain the status quo is to get someone who can be used. Olusegun was brought out of Prison, pardoned; and some people have gone to prostrate to get him back to the State house to collect "what he forgot there". What an irony!

Suddenly, he is doling out millions as donation to a party that had not adopted him. The money is from some faceless friends. Is it as "shares" or as "hush money"? It is not out of charity that one could give out such heavy amount for nothing "There is fire on the mountain".

Still we have no Constitution. All delaying tactics have been in place. The local Governments elections have come and gone. Governors and State Houses of Assembly members have been elected. No sign of goal posts for a level playing field. And money carries the day.

I have mentioned how in Russia, Yetsin became President before the

Constitution. And he became more powerful than the Constitution. Babangida wanted to use the National Assembly to become President. Abacha was to promulgate the Constitution after becoming President. A retired military man is on the way now. Let us beware of a wonder Constitution.

Can we really trust Abubakar? That is the great question now. Let us examine the following facts:

- (1) I believed him when in his first broadcast that he was leaving on the 1st of October 1998. I believed he could have freed Abiola or get him to be attended to by doctors immediately he came to power if he did not succumb to pressure. There are three of our nationals who high jacked a Nigerian airways plane at the time (1994) Nigeria was boiling with protests against June 12, languishing in Niger Republic jail.
