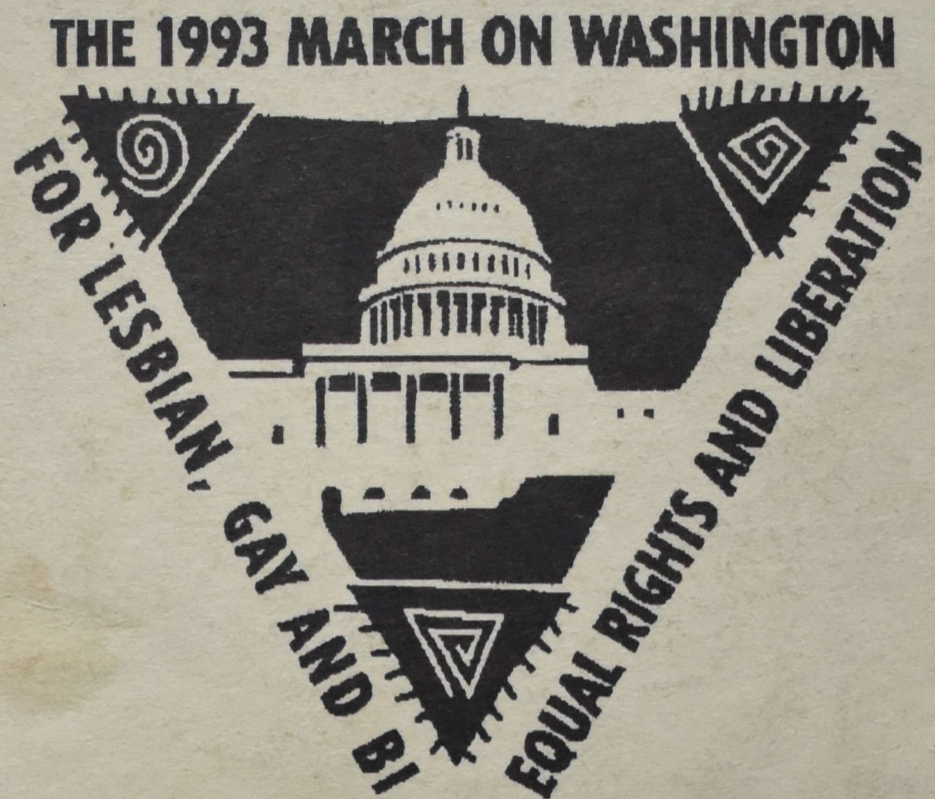
April 25 March on Washington for Lesbian, Gay, and Bisexual Equal Rights and Liberation
