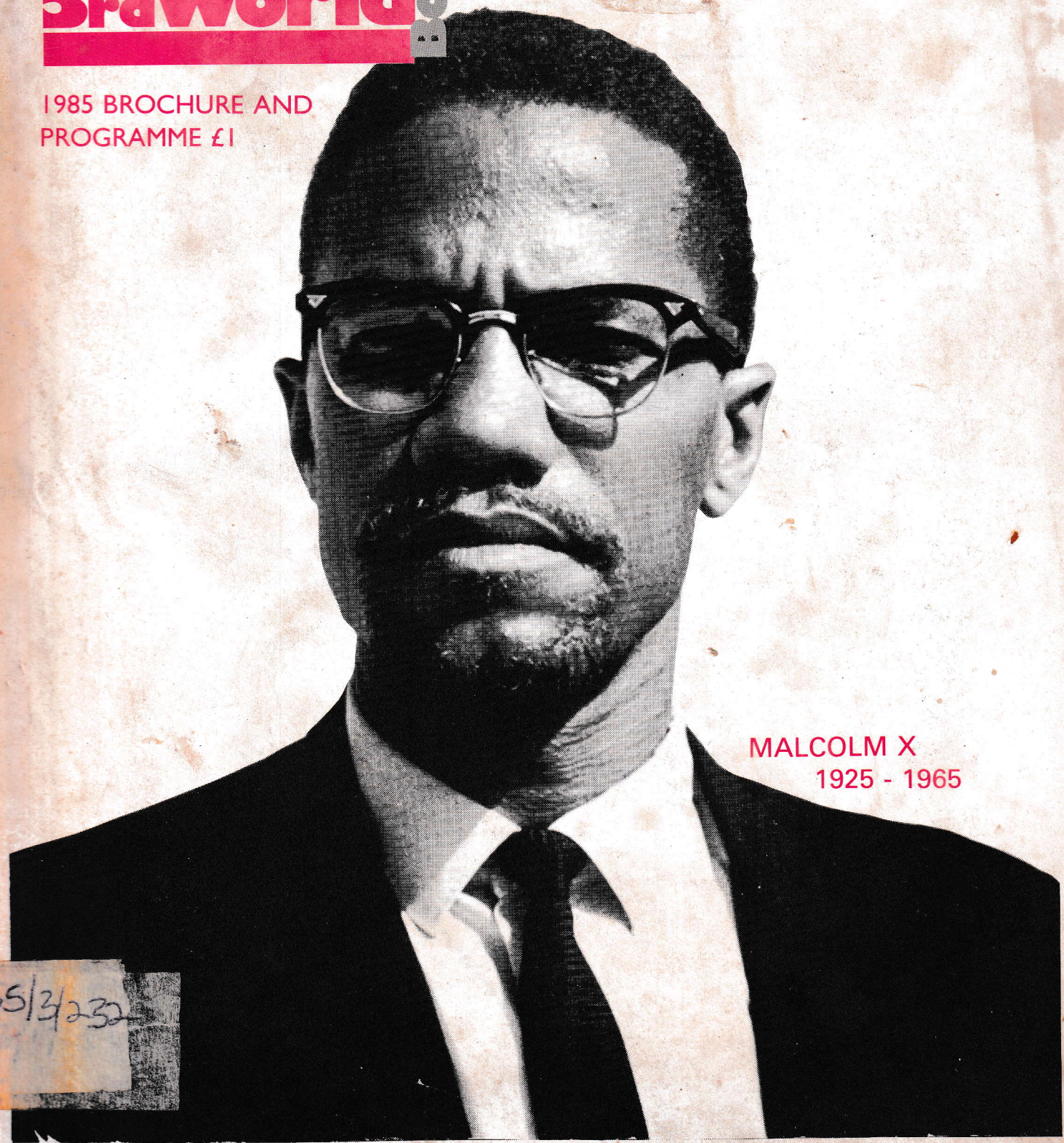

## WELCOME TO THE BOOK FAIR

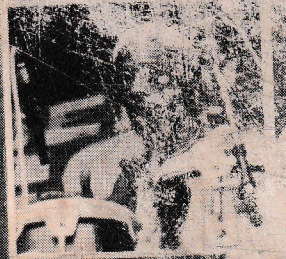
We, the Organising Committee, welcome you once again to this the Fourth International Book Fair of Radical Black and Third World Books and the Book Fair Festival Week.
