


# Outstanding artists of our time

During the grim nazi years, Fritz Cremer (1906), a sculptor from the GDR, remained true to the progressive ideals of our time. group His sculpture "Mothers", composed of four figures (1939), is highly dramatic, each figure indicting nazi misrule and tyranny. A detail of it is reproduced here.

Cremer's monument to the Resistance fighters, part of the memorial complex, is a requiem for the victims **Buchenwald** of the concentration camp and a hymn to its prisoners who rose up against the nazi butchers in April 1945. The sculptor has also fashioned lyrical works, such as "Young Love", as well as those of a high civic nature.
