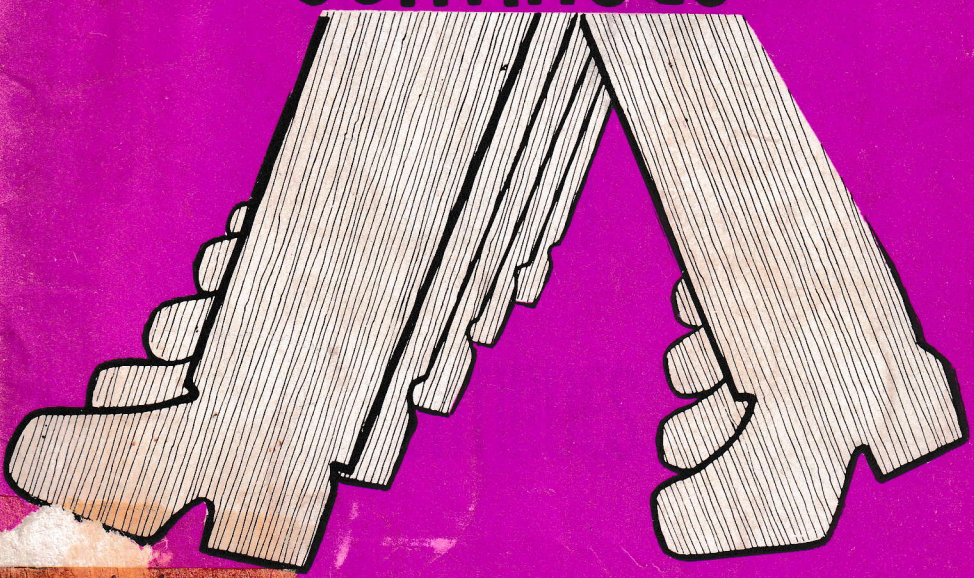

His Excellency Lt.-General Olusegun Obasanjo, Head of State and Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.

On June 29, 1976, Lt.-General Olusegun Obasanjo, Head of State and Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces, addressed the nation on the Federal Military Government's new approach to agriculture and the marketing board system; phase two of the indigenisation programme; the problem of high rents; the setting up of a land reform commission; incomes policy; and the new orientation in Nigeria's foreign policy.

Concluding his speech, the Head of State noted: "However grand Government plans are, they will have little chance of success if they do not receive the active support and participation of all Nigerians. Failure in these plans and endeavours will not only spell disaster for us and our children, but for the whole of Africa. We will not fail."
