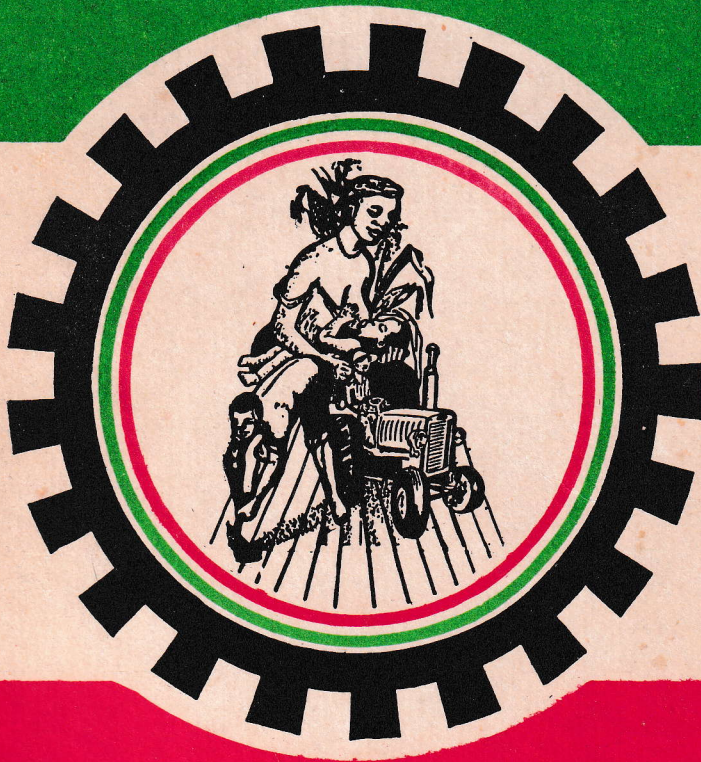

The flag of the Nigerian Labour Party is horizontal stripes of green, white red from the top with encircled black superimposed wheel of industry on the white. This is the symbolic expression of the credo that through our own struggle we will achieve victory, peace, national self-sufficiency and prosperity.
