21ST ANNIVERSARY AND 113 JOURNALS

Another 16 journals have joined the Carfax list in the last 12 months taking the number published to over 100 for the first time since Carfax Publishing Company was formed 21 years ago. Our specialisation in publishing only academic and learned journals has been a fundamental factor in our expansion from just one journal in the early 1970s to 113 today.

Carfax Publishing Company is the trading name of Journals Oxford Ltd which was originally based near to Carfax - the crossroads at the centre of Oxford and is now based in Abingdon some seven miles south of its original location.

The very first journal published was *Comparative Education*, success with which led to other titles in related areas so that we now publish over 30 journals in the field of education. In recent years we have, whilst remaining very active in our original market, expanded further - especially into the fields of science, technology and medicine. As a result of this development we now publish academic journals dealing with subjects as diverse as philosophy, psychiatry, psychology, economics, statistics, sociology and the arts.

Our growth continues by both the highly selective launch of new titles and the strategic acquisition of existing journals which we bring from our specialised care to editorial, production and management.

ADDICTION AND MEDICINE

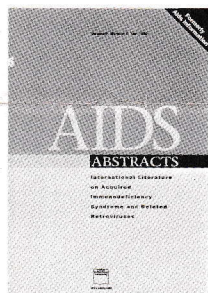
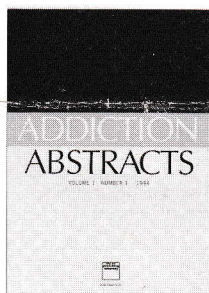
The Carfax list in the field of addiction grows with the launch of two new journals in 1994.

Addiction Abstracts, a quarterly international current awareness journal will cover the whole field of addictive behaviours providing rapid access to the most recent literature. The abstracts will provide a comprehensive survey of topical papers selected by an international team of experts. Clear indexing will enable readers, whether they work in the academic community, or in treatment and prevention, to locate full bibliographic references swiftly.

Edited by Michael Gossop of the National Addiction Centre in London, *Addiction Abstracts* emerges from the same stable as *Addiction* - now established as the world's leading monthly journal in the subject.

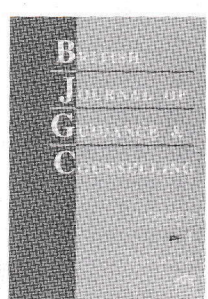
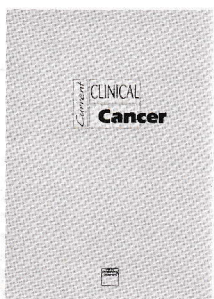
Published three times a year *Drugs: education, prevention and policy* is a multi-disciplinary journal on the prevention of substance misuse and related problems. The journal will address education and prevention policy and its application in the community. It is aimed not only at specialists in the drugs field but also at educationists, criminologists

and law-enforcement officers, probation officers, psychologists, social workers, scientists, administrators and policy planners. The editor Stuart Ware of the Trust for Information and Prevention intends that *Drugs: education, prevention and policy* will question and improve the relevance and validity of current drug policy as it relates to both legal, and illicit substances.



Since its launch in 1988 *AIDS Care* has established itself as one of the most important international journals in the field of HIV/AIDS. Initially published in three issues per year, *AIDS Care* rapidly expanded to quarterly and in 1994 will expand again to five issues per year in response to the rising international tide of high-quality papers.

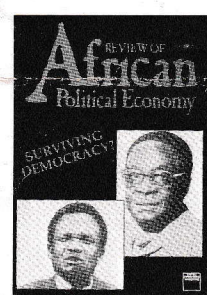
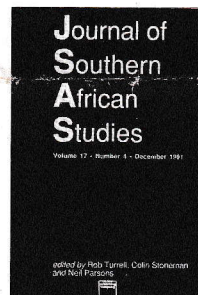
In 1993 Carfax joined with the Oncology Information Service at the University of Leeds to publish *AIDS Abstracts*. In 1994 this relationship grows with the publication of *Current Clinical Cancer*. Previously a series of separate bulletins called Oncology Information, this major service will be restructured and relaunched as a new monthly contents listing journal called *Current Clinical Cancer*. The contents of a constantly updated list of over 1,300 major international bio-medical journals will be covered by *Current Clinical Cancer* within five weeks of publication - making the journal the fastest listing service available in this field. *Current Clinical Cancer* will retain the exclusive focus of its predecessor on the vital clinical aspects of cancer but will now provide all the information in one convenient monthly, fully cross-indexed source. *Current Clinical Cancer* will also be available on computer disk as *Current Clinical Cancer on PC Disk*.



Carfax are also delighted to announce the acquisition of the highly respected and long-established *British Journal of Guidance and Counselling*. Published in association with CRAC, the Careers Research and Advisory Centre, and edited by Tony Watts, *British Journal of Guidance and Counselling* provides a forum for debate between academics, trainers and practitioners on the theory and practice of guidance and counselling; the provision of services as well as training and professional issues. The journal draws on a variety of disciplines and methodologies and explores the interface between guidance and counselling and their relationship to other cognate subject fields such as education, psychotherapy and social work.

AFRICAN STUDIES

Carfax's strength in area studies journals is given a new continental dimension by the addition of two leading African studies journals to our list. *Journal of Southern African Studies*, which was founded in 1974 and formerly published by Oxford University Press, publishes southern African studies work that draws significant connections between the humanities and social sciences. The journal reflects new theoretical approaches and discusses the methodological framework in general use by students of the area. The region covered by the journal includes: the Republic of South Africa, Namibia, Botswana, Lesotho and Swaziland; Angola and Mozambique; Zambia, Malawi, Zimbabwe and, occasionally, Zaire, the Malagasy Republic and Mauritius.



Review of African Political Economy (known worldwide as ROAPE) is to be published quarterly by Carfax for the ROAPE international editorial collective from 1994 (issue number 59). Now 20 years' old, ROAPE is a fully refereed journal covering all aspects of African political economy. ROAPE has always involved the readership in shaping the journal's coverage, welcoming contributions from grass roots organisations, women's organisations, trade unions and political groups. The journal is unique in the comprehensiveness of its bibliographic referencing, information monitoring, statistical documentation and coverage of work-in-progress.

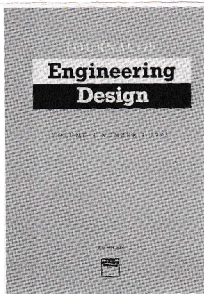
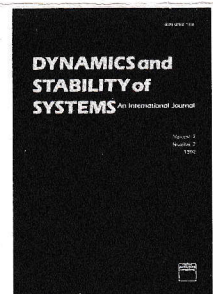
EDUCATION

Carfax are world leaders in the field of education and the growth of our list continues with another new launch in 1994. *Assessment in Education: principles, policy and practice* will be edited jointly by the Centre for Curriculum and Assessment Studies (CAS) at the University of Bristol and the International Centre for Research on Assessment (ICRA) at the Institute of Education, University of London. The editorial board led by Professor Patricia Broadfoot is supported by a strong international advisory board. Educational assessment has become increasingly prominent as a policy issue and there has been a growth of interest in modes of assessment to promote, as well as measure standards and quality. *Assessment in Education: principles, policy and practice* will address these issues by providing a focus for the increasing scholarly output in the field.



LAW AND LEGAL STUDIES

Carfax first entered the field of law by taking over the *International Yearbook of Law, Computers and Technology* from Butterworths and now extends its presence in the field with the launch of *International Journal of the Legal Profession* in 1994. Published initially three times per year the journal is edited by Avrom Sherr, Professor of Law at the University of Liverpool. The journal has attracted an extensive and influential international advisory board of over 50 experts drawn from a wide variety of professional contexts and countries. *International Journal of the Legal Profession* is an academic journal which will address the organisation, structure and management of the legal profession encompassing studies of legal work, practice, skills and ethics.



ENGINEERING

Carfax announces the acquisition from Oxford University Press of *Dynamics and Stability of Systems* as from 1994 (Vol.9). Edited by K. Huseyin, Department of Systems Design Engineering, University of Waterloo, Ontario. *Dynamics and Stability of Systems* presents original research on the stability, instability, bifurcation and oscillatory behaviour of natural and man-made systems. Papers vary from those describing new phenomena, through those presenting new theories or analytical methods applicable to a broad class of systems, to those

applications that are based on valid mathematical models. *Dynamics and Stability of Systems* adds to the growing list of Carfax titles in engineering including *Journal of Engineering Design* now in its fifth successful year under the editorship of Derek Sheldon the Lucas Professor at the School of Engineering, Coventry University and the long established *European Journal of Engineering Education* - published by Carfax in association with the European Society for Engineering Education.

CHANGES OF TITLE

A number of Carfax journals will change their title in 1994: *Disability, Handicap and Society* will become simply *Disability and Society*. *Innovation in Social Sciences Research* will become *Innovation: European journal of the social sciences*.

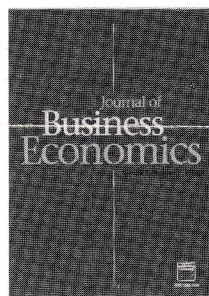
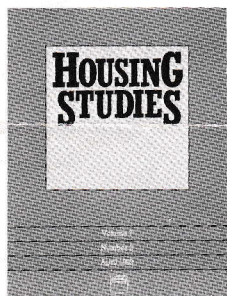
EUROPE-ASIA STUDIES

Following the successful refocus and relaunch of *Soviet Studies* as *Europe-Asia Studies*, the journal is again expanding its coverage in 1994 with the publication of two issues dedicated to Soviet History. These will publish work by both Western and Russian and other ex-Soviet scholars on the history of the Soviet period and system, especially work that draws on newly available source material. A special Soviet History Editorial Group consisting of two University of Glasgow and two external members, is being set up in order to help with the procurement and peer-reviewed assessment of articles for the Soviet History issues.

Our publishing in this field is further strengthened by *Nationalities Papers*, the only journal dealing exclusively with all non-Russian nationalities of the former Soviet Union and national minorities in Central and East European countries. The problems and importance of over 120 million people are treated within the disciplinary and methodological contexts of European-Asia Studies. Of central concern is the fate of the Balts, Ukrainians, Jews, Caucasians and the peoples of Central Asia. The journal will continue to be edited by Henry R. Huttenbach of The City College of New York, and is published on behalf of the Association for the Study of the Nationalities.

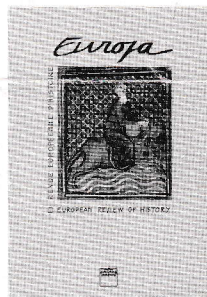
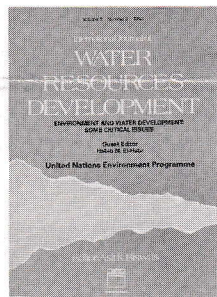

The journal covers all aspects of water development and management in both industrialised and Third World countries. Contents focus on the practical implementation of policies for water resources development, monitoring and evaluation of technical projects, and, to a lesser extent, water resources research. Articles are rigorous and in-depth, ranging in approach from applied geographical analysis to the examination of strategic economic and social issues. The journal remains under the editorship of Professor Asit K. Biswas, President of the International Water Resources Association and the International Society for Ecological Modelling.



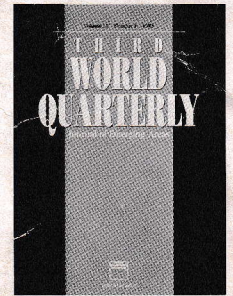
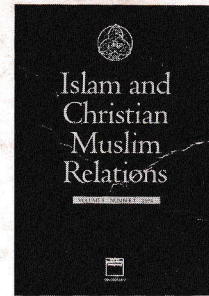
HISTORY

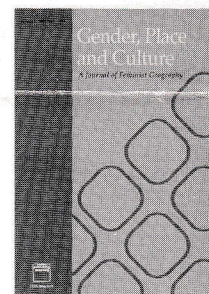
